Professor Leela Gandhi received her D.Phil. from Balliol College, Oxford and has been teaching at the University of Chicago since 2007. In 2006, she authored *Affective Communities: Anticolonial Thought, Fin de Siècle Radicalism, and the Politics of Friendship* (Duke University Press) and in 1998, *Postcolonial Theory: A Critical Introduction* (Columbia University Press). She co-authored *England Through Colonial Eyes in Twentieth-Century Fiction* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2001). She is the founding co-editor of *The Journal of Postcolonial Studies* and has published many articles, the latest being "The Pauper's Gift: Postcolonial Studies and the New Democratic Dispensation," *Public Culture* (2011) and "After Virtue: Notes on C20th Socialist Antimaterialism," *English Literary History* (2010).
